



State Convention 2020 NEW Deadlines

June 1, 2020

DEADLINE for Officers of each Congressional District Committee to appoint one (1) member to serve on the Committee on Credentials. If no delegate is appointed by June 1, 2020, the State Chairman shall appoint a delegate from the district to serve.

The officers of each Congressional District shall also appoint one (1) delegate from their district to serve as Honorary Vice-Chairman of the State Convention and one (1) delegate from their district to serve as Honorary Assistant Secretary of the State Convention.

June 2, 2020

PRIMARY ELECTION DAY State Convention delegate candidates in contested races will be elected

June 9, 2020

DEADLINE at 5:00pm, the County Chairman shall Communicate all State Convention delegates (both elected on June 2nd and appointments made under Rule 7-9) in the form prescribed by the State Committee to the State Secretary.

The State Chairman can extend this deadline on a case by case basis to not later than noon on June 12, 2020. County Chairman must petition the State Chairman and demonstrate that the cause for the delay is in the delay in counting ballots by such county's election board.

No appointments or substitutions may be made after this deadline.

DEADLINE for Convention Delegates to pay their assessment fee. The State Secretary shall provide to each county party reports of those delegates who pay by credit card and personal check.

DEADLINE for County Committees to submit all delegate assessment fees collected by them to the State Secretary

June 11, 2020

DEADLINE at Noon, for a county to replace any delegate who did not pay their fee may be replaced with another who will pay the fee no later than June 11, 2020. If the delegate has not paid or no suitable replacement has been found by this date, NO delegate may be appointed.

DEADLINE to submit a challenge to a delegate to be heard at the Credentials Committee meeting on June 12, 2020.

June 12, 2020

At noon, last date that a County Committee may be granted an extension by the State Chairman for submitting contested delegates due to a counting delay by the county election board.

MEETING of the Committee on Credentials shall convene at 1:00 pm ET (either in-person or by electronic means) to handle any challenges described in Rule 7-16.

June 22, 2020

APPROXIMATE date that delegates will receive their ballot in the mail from an independent third-party vendor.

June 29, 2020

FIRST DATE to notify the State Committee if a delegate has not received their State Convention ballot in the mail

July 9, 2020

DEADLINE at 5:00 PM ET for a delegate's ballot to be received by the third-party accounting firm accepting ballots through the mail.

July 10, 2020

Ballots will be delivered by the third-party accounting firm to the State Committee and the total number of ballots submitted will be announced and attested to by the firm.

BALLOT COUNTING will commence at 10:00 am ET. Ballots will be checked in before being opened, then will be separated from their envelope prior to counting to protect the anonymity of the delegate's vote.

Each candidate may designate up to three delegates as watchers who would be allowed to be present for the counting of ballots.

July 15, 2020

DEADLINE by noon, for the State Chairman and State Secretary to certify the nominees for the Indiana Republican Party for the offices of Lt. Governor and Attorney General to the Secretary of State.
